Today, we have a total strength of 1240 students and 89 dedicated teaching and nonteaching staff. Our school continues to progress leaps and bounds, striving to fulfil its mission of being a 'School with a Difference'.

To meet the needs of the hour our Vidyalaya has integrated the **Chinmaya Vision Programme** with academics, aiming to shape students into emotionally balanced individuals. This approach fosters the holistic development of each student, helping them grow into compassionate and well-rounded human beings.

School Praveshanolsavam

➤ The School Praveshanolsavam was organized on June 3, 2024, with a vibrant welcome featuring Chanda, decorated umbrellas, thalam, and a welcome song by the Plus Two students. Sweets were distributed to LKG and UKG students. The Principal delivered the welcome address, and Shri T.V. Jayakrishnan, the Correspondent, presided over the event. CBSE Result

- Excellence in academics is a hallmark of any esteemed institution. Once again, our students have excelled in the CBSE Board Exams, bringing pride and adding yet another feather to our cap.
- ➤ The CBSE Results for Classes X and XII were declared on May 13th, 2024. For Plus Two, in the Science stream, Niranjana S scored 96.6%, Fadi Bin Siddique scored 93.8%, Vaibhav Vidyadharan and Devika Surendran scored 93% respectively. In Computer Science, Adhil Aboobacker scored 98.2%, Serena Elizabeth Jacob scored 95.8%, and Viswas Govind K.V.

scored 95.6%. In the Commerce stream, Niranjana Mohan scored 97.2%, Pratika Krishna scored 96.2%, and Sreeshyam T scored 95.4%.

- To summarize, <u>81 students appeared for the XII Board Exam</u>, of which <u>36 secured above 90%</u>, <u>34 students received distinction</u>, and <u>11 students passed with 1st class</u>.
- For Class X, 87 students appeared for the exams. Out of these, <u>67 students received distinction</u>, which means <u>77%</u> of the students passed with distinction. <u>17 students secured 1st class</u>, and <u>3 students passed with 2nd class</u>. This success was made possible by the teamwork of our dedicated and diligent students, staff, and parents.

The CBSE toppers, subject toppers, and students who scored A1 in all subjects at our school were awarded by Pujya Swami Viviktananda Saraswati at a function held in our school auditorium on 24th May.

• Spoken English Crash Course:

A 10-day Spoken English Crash Course designed specifically for teachers was held from April 2nd to 15th.
